Aimed at 5-8 year olds (Key Stage 1), the entry level training programme is provided by qualified 'Activators' with full enhanced DBS Checks and child safeguarding certificates. With all of the local clubs having pathways to continue into junior cricket for girls and boys. All participants that sign-up will receive an All-Stars cricket t-shirt.

Dynamos Cricket is designed for those 9-11 year olds new to cricket or not yet ready for the junior pathway at the club. This softball cricket offer is great to build confidence in a lifelong sporting activity. All participants who take part will do so with trained 'Activators', and will receive an New Balance shirt. 
Every body join the super movement!


